
ANSI/ISEA 105-2024 NEW LOOK. SAME HIGH LEVEL OF PROTECTION.

SAFETY ICONS WITH EASIER-TO-IDENTIFY LEVELS OF PROTECTION

Look for a new safety icon combining ANSI/ISEA 105 Abrasion, Cut and Puncture resistance standards. It's a simple change designed to make it easier to identify the protection levels offered by your work gloves.

While no changes are being made in the current levels of protection, or the testing methods used, for the ANSI/ISEA 105 abrasion, cut and puncture resistance standards—the new pentagon-shaped icon will make it easier for end users to choose, and for distributors to supply, the right level of hand protection for any task.





Eliminating the multiple icons showing the levels of abrasion, cut and puncture resistance, the new icon combines all three levels of protection. It will also clearly display whether the gloves being used offer one, two, or all three classifications of protection offered, as can be seen in the following examples.
